Embroidery & Stitching	Threads & Yarns	Tapestry Wool, Stranded Cotton, Broder Cotton, Metallic Thread, Pearle Cotton, Wool
	TIP: Use a backing fabric (i.e. interlace, wadding) or an embroidery hoop to hold the fabric stable when stitching.	Hessian, Cotton, Wooden Threading Shapes, Stitching Cards, Christmas Cut Out Threading Cards (Circle & Triangle)
	Sewing Needles	Early Years: Plastic Darning Needles suitable for Hessian and Paper Large Eye & Sharp Point = Chenille Needles, Bulk Tapestry Chenille Needles, Hand Sewing Needles
Weaving	Warp = the weaving structure	Kraft Weaving Shapes, Cardboard Weaving Loom, Woven Braid, Galvanised Hoops
	Weft = materials that are interlaced over and under through the warp.	Natural Braid, Acrylic Wool, Stocking Pieces, Cords etc
